



## 12-14-2020 \*Trash pick-up day has been changed to Thursdays effective February 1, 2021

Several notices regarding Trash Cans have been previously handed out to your tenants, yet the message has not gotten through. The pick-up schedule for trash cans are Tuesday mornings and every other Tuesday for Recycle Bins.

To be clear, trash cans are to be rolled out no earlier than 6 pm on Monday and pushed back in no later than 6 pm on Tuesday.

Cans found left on the street on Wednesday morning will be photographed.

Owners will receive a violation.

If this is a repeat violation, a hearing notice requiring a \$200.00 dollar fine will be issued!

This fine will be added to the offending units account.

## City Code 13.10.190

As required by the City of Sacramento codes and ordinances referenced below, trash cans are to be pulled out 12 hours prior and no later than 12 hours after the scheduled pick-up.

Placing receptacles for collection

- A. If there is more than one collection can, the cans shall be placed closely together in one location and shall be placed within two feet of the curb. Receptacles used for the collection of garbage shall be placed as set forth in this section. The cans must be placed in a manner such as to be in front of any fence or other barrier or enclosure, and readily accessible from the street or alley on which the collectors conduct their route.
- B. Automatic lift containers shall be placed at least two feet from any obstruction, including an adjacent automatic lift container.
- C. The can or cans shall be placed for collection no earlier than twelve (12) hours prior to the scheduled collection time and only for such additional period as may be incident to collection. The can or cans shall be moved back to their normal storage location not later than twelve (12) hours after collection. No can placed for collection shall be placed on any public sidewalk or street in a manner which impedes traffic or drainage or in any manner which creates a hazard. Any can or cans placed for collection shall be placed in a manner which will provide the collector at least thirty-two (32) inches unimpeded access thereto.
- D. For properties, places and premises serviced by the city, any cans placed for collection to qualify for the rates set forth in the city's fee and charge manual shall be placed in the manner set forth in this section. (Ord. 2000-036 § 2(a) (part); Ord. 2000-017 § 3 (part); prior code § 19.01.122)

An additional concern is people are not rolling their trash cans out regularly and they are getting "over full". This cause trash to fall out into common areas thus breeding possible insect infestations.
